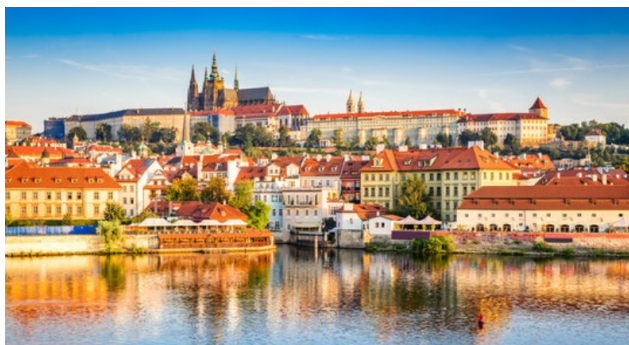

Publication

The ISD Proceedings will be available as **open access** in the Association for Information Systems (AIS) eLibrary. On top of that, Springer will publish a selection of the best papers (by invitation) as a separate volume of the Lecture Notes in Information Systems and Organization (LNISO) series. The proceedings will be submitted for indexation by Scopus, Google Scholar, DBLP, Semantic Scholar, and Web of Science / Conference Proceedings Citation Index.

Conference fees

The registration fee for presenting authors is 600 EUR, 500 EUR for active AIS members, and 400 EUR for students. Discounts apply for additional papers and non-presenting participants. The registration fee includes lunches, coffee breaks, welcome reception, and a gala dinner with a sightseeing tour.
